 - Persian Gulf
 - Mediterranean Sea
 - Bay of Biscay
 - North Sea
 - Gulf of Mexico
 - Baltic Sea
 - Mozambique Channel
 - Weddell Sea
 - Straits of Gibraltar
 - English Channel

3. On the Oceans map, circle, label or otherwise make clear the following areas:
 - Two areas of the oceans that are regularly prone to non-tropical storms and violent weather.
 - An area where piracy is still a problem
 - An area where there exists a chance for war to break out.
 - An area prone to hurricanes
 - Three choke points for commercial shipping.
